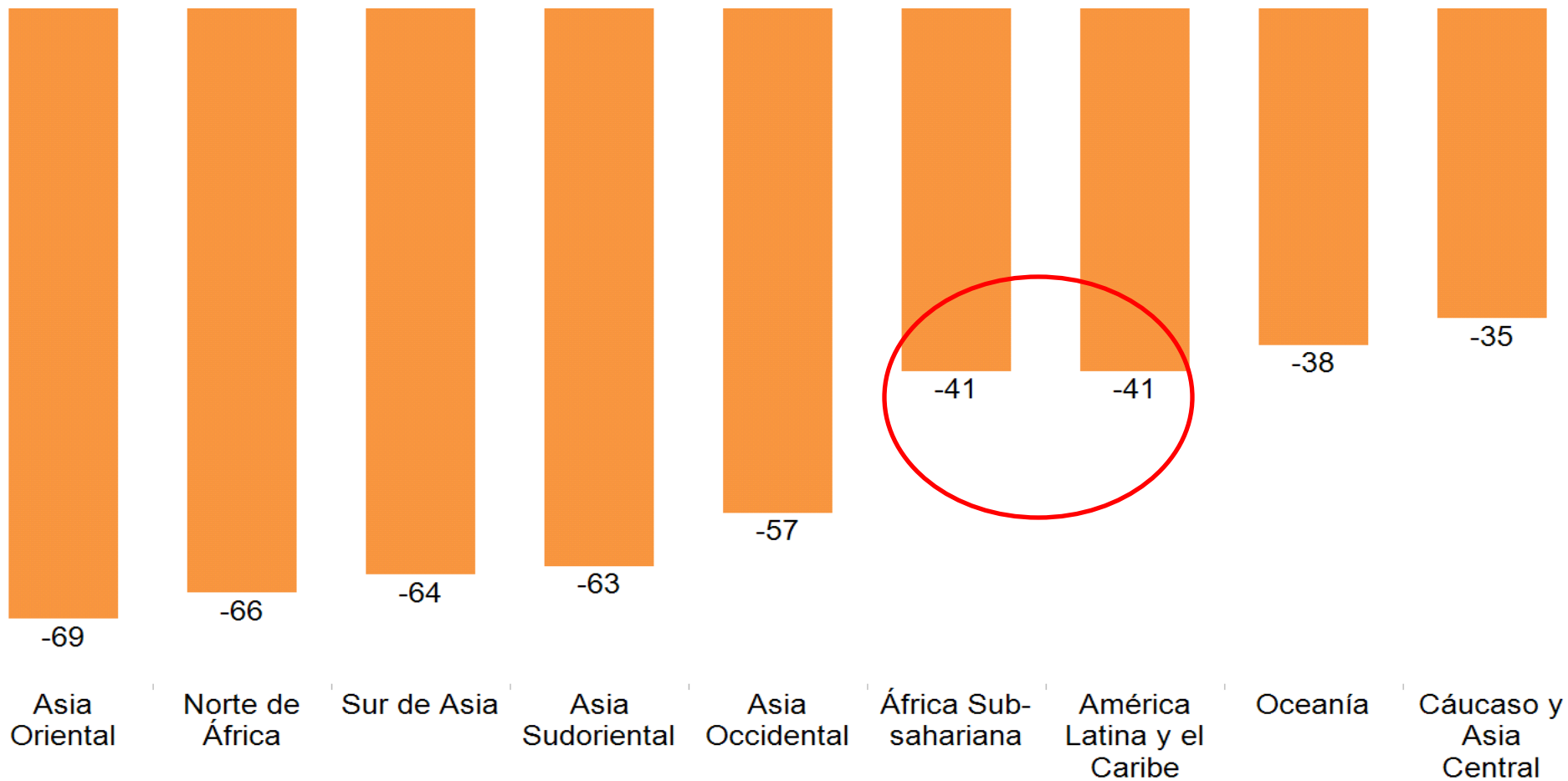

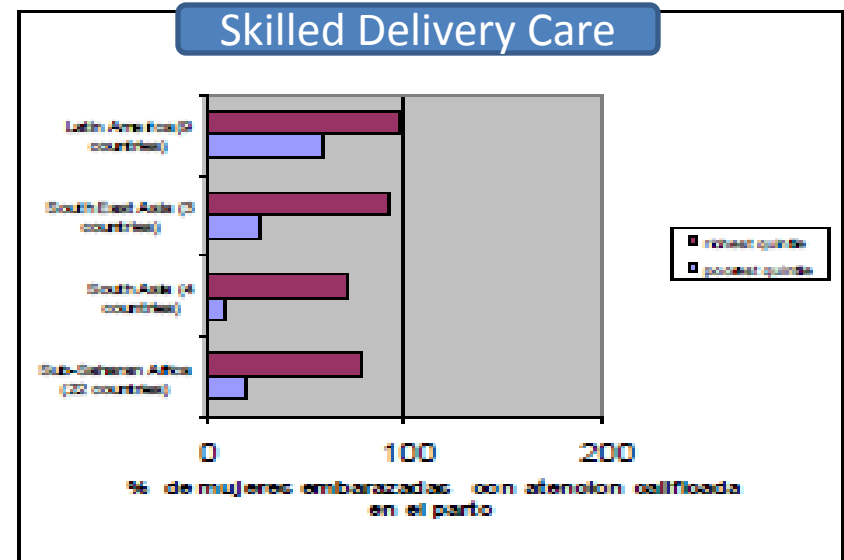
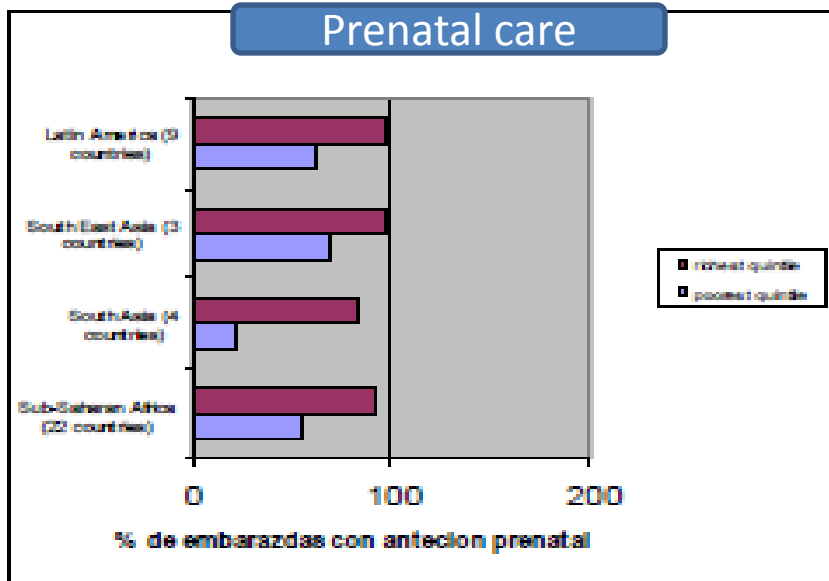

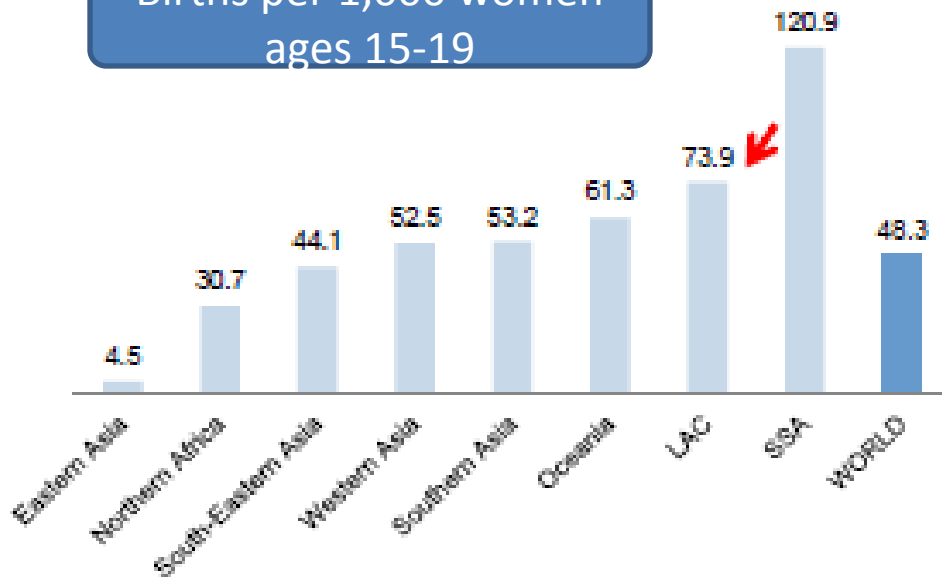
# Poverty and RSH Indicators: High correlation

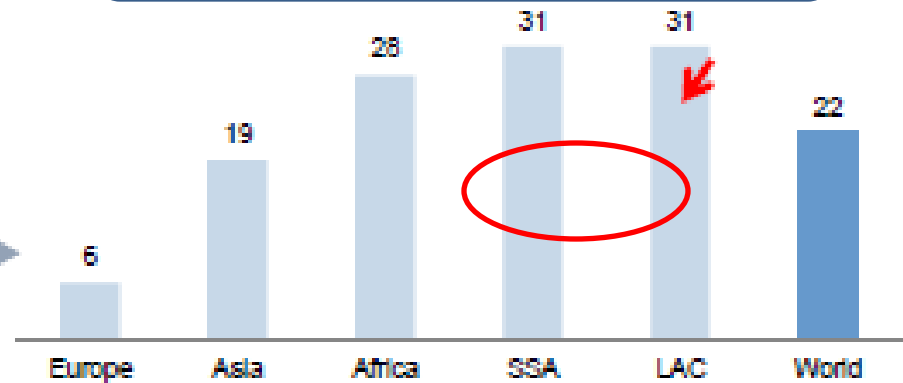
# Fertility Rate in Adolescents: 2007
