Ground Truth: The next big thing for youth access to supplies

Global stats tell us that over 70,000 adolescents die annually from causes related to pregnancy and child birth while pregnancy-related complications and HIV remain the leading causes of death among girls aged 15-19 and 20-24. Most of the world's births to adolescents - 95% - occur in developing countries, with about 19% of them likely to become pregnant before age 18, 3% before they are 15. In 27 countries, over 1 in 4 young women age 20 to 24 reports a birth before age 18. 22 of these countries are in sub-Saharan Africa.

These numbers point to the fact that young people, especially in the Third World, need access to affordable high quality RH supplies. However, how can we <u>better understand young</u> <u>people's knowledge of and attitudes toward supplies</u> so as to identify and deliver interventions that respond to felt needs and generate a high level of enthusiasm so that participation and ownership is ensured?
