Access to commodities and family planning services



The use of contraception among adolescents has increased.
The unmet need has hardly declined.



Overall, support to the health sector, UNFPA and INGOs has led to a slightly increased use of family planning services. Inequalities persist. In Ghana and Mali the unmet need has not decreased.
