- What shapes the markets that operate in different countries: the public sector, private sector, NGOs, FBOs, commercial
- Regarding indicators that determine how a program is performing, across methods, nothing measures the range of choice.
- Stockouts are measured by individual methods but not by a package of methods, or category of methods.
- How does a program manager measure choice on a routine basis? People don't currently do this. What are the incentives to measure choice?
- Definition of Choice: is more necessarily better? Are there a minimum number of methods that should be available?
- What does choice mean to the woman or the couple?
- Accountability, like choice, is a term thrown around a lot without a clear definition.
- How is accountability maintained, what is the outcome, and how is it achieved?
- Can we incentivize choice?
