## Basics of RHSC climate change survey

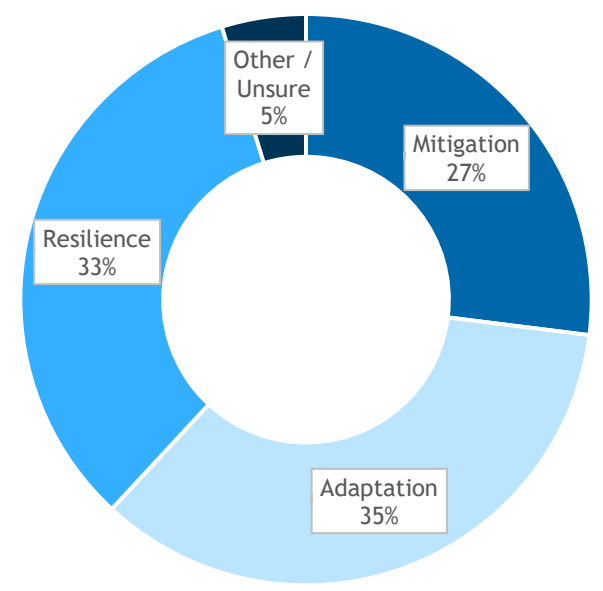
- Titled “Moving forward on climate and reproductive health”

- 0 French

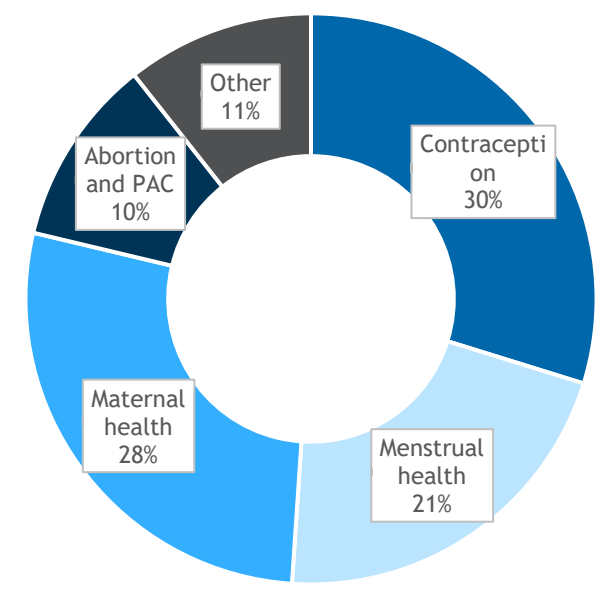

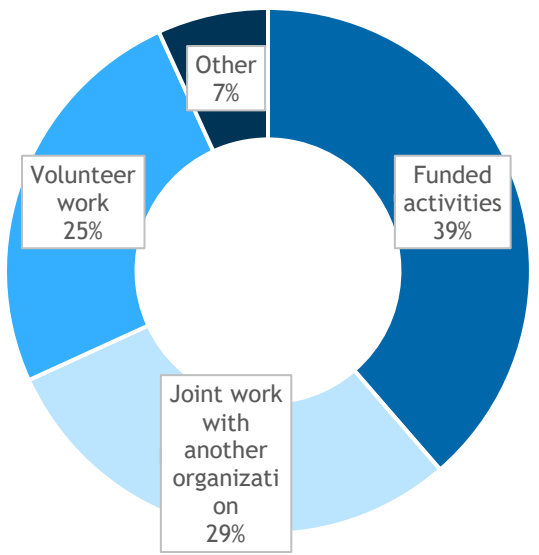
What health area is your climate change work related to?

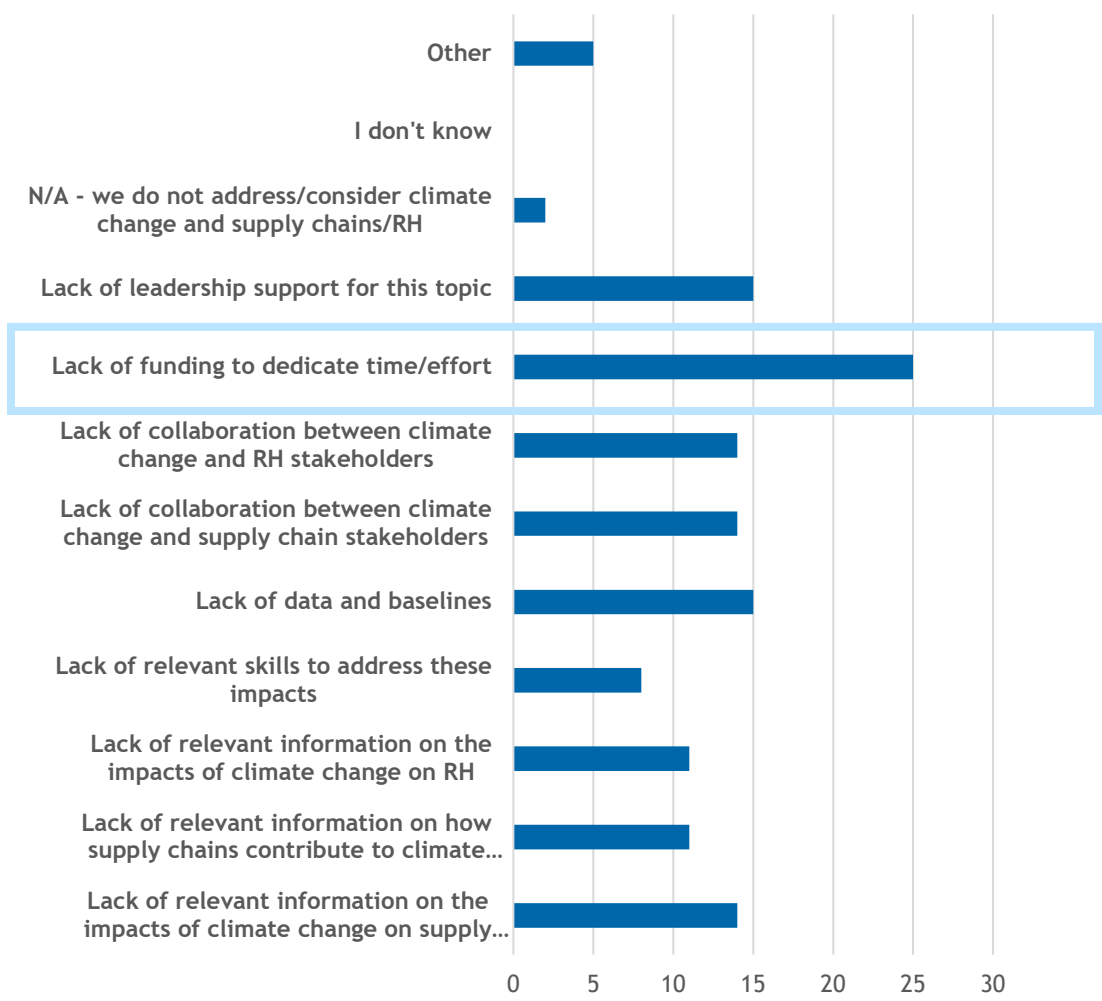

How are your organization's current activities on climate change being funded, organized, and implemented?



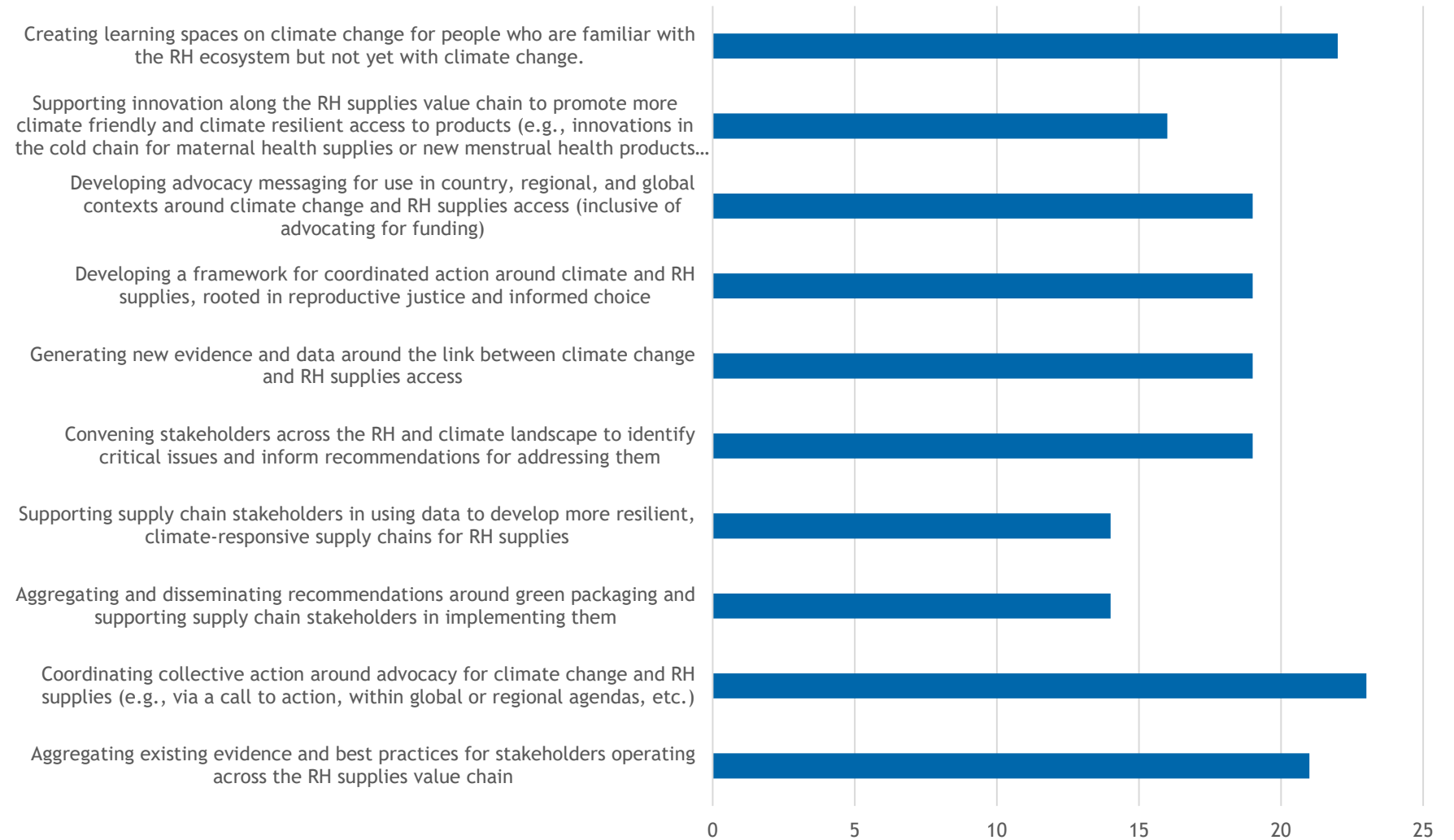

What barriers does your organization face when addressing or considering climate change impacts on supply chains/RH?



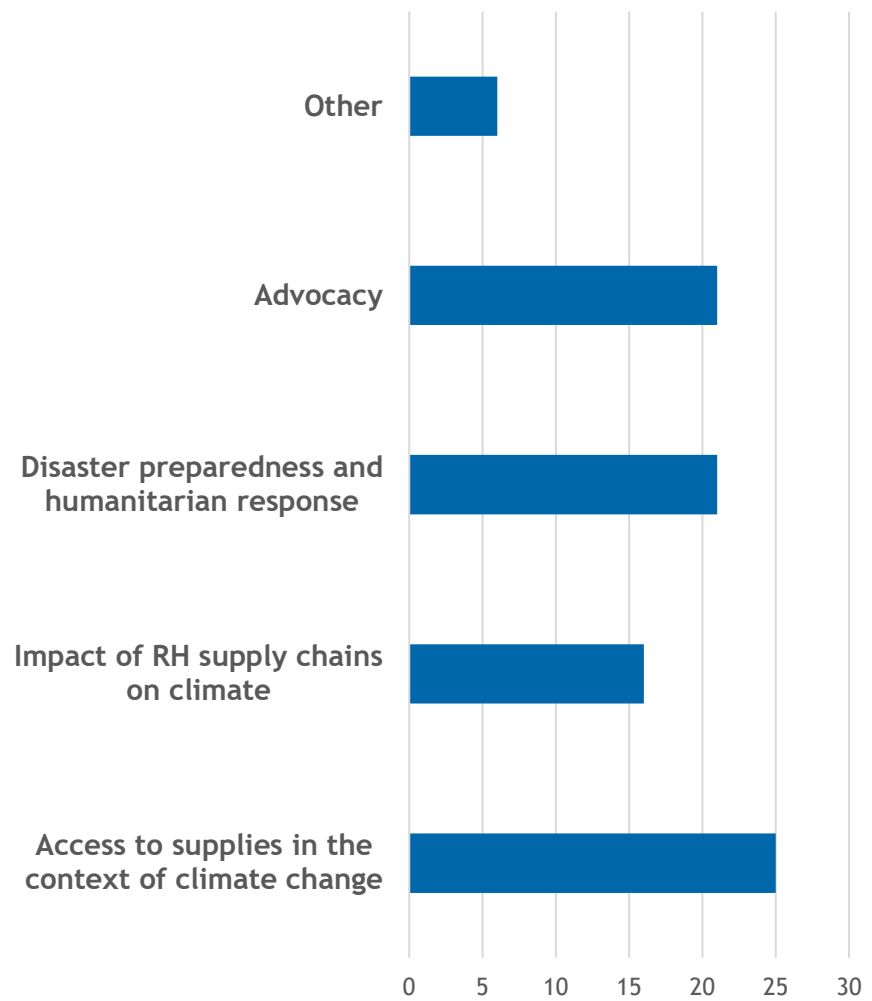
# What type of action would you like to see the RHSC take?

## What type of activity would you like to see RHSC take relating to climate change and RH supplies (select all that apply)?

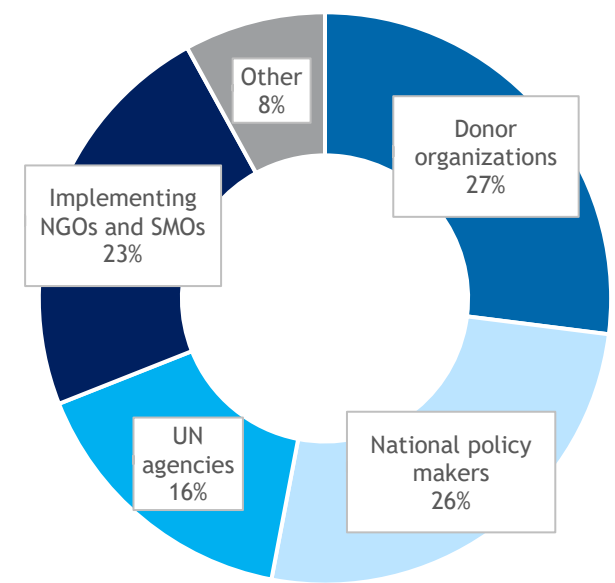


# Potential call to action related to climate change and RH supplies
